The offering provides funding for all WMUV missions and ministries and makes possible other special ministries, outreach projects, and initiatives not funded through regular means of giving connected to BGAV.



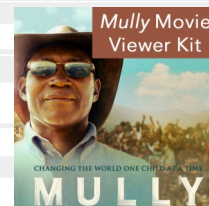
Join WMU in doing an **Undy Sunday**, this fall!

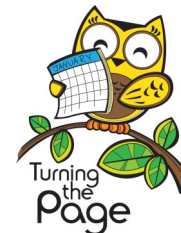
